## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

# 2021 ANNUAL PHOTOBOOK COMPETITION

## **Competition Requirements**

The following are conditions that must be met for an entry to qualify for the competition:

- Entrants must be either:
  - o A current member of UNSW PhotoClub and therefore be entitled for free entry; or
  - A non-UNSW PhotoClub member but a UNSW staff or student, and pay an entry fee of \$2 (Arc member) or \$3 (Non-Arc member) to UNSW PhotoClub
- Each entrant is entitled to a total of 7 submissions for the competition. A maximum of 2 photos can be submitted per category. Additional submissions will not be entertained. You can submit less than seven.
- All entries must be relevant for its chosen category If the executive committee has reasons to believe that a photo is not in the correct category, it may: 1) choose to shift an entry into a different category; 2) Ask the entrant to resubmit; 3) Disqualify the entry. However, it is the entrant's responsibility to submit their photos to the correct categories. Entrants may ask the committee, if they are unsure, before submission.
- All entries must not consist of any profanity, pornographic content, or be disrespectful to any race or religion
- Entrants must be the author and sole owner of all submissions
- All entries must not have been entered into previous or other competitions
- There are no formal time limits for when entries were taken
- Entrants retain all rights to their entries but must understand that images submitted to the competition can be used by UNSW PhotoClub for marketing/promotional and educational purposes of the UNSW PhotoClub *Entries will not be used by or handed over to any third parties outside the PhotoClub unless they are within the above stated purposes.*

## **Submission Guidelines**

- Submission Requirements: Each Image should be of the following approximate dimensions: 8" x 12" or at 2400 x 3600 pixels or equivalent, at 300DPI
- Images must also not have any added framing, borders, watermarks, words, or captions within it, or it may be disqualified. The title of entries and photographer details are to be submitted separately in the email as per the following instructions in the submission procedures.
- General photo editing is allowed, but complete photo manipulation is not. Basic editing of colour, contrast, vignetting, general correction via content aware, etc. are allowed, but not wholescale replacement or inclusion of elements in a photo. Major manipulation of colours or added special effects are also generally not encouraged.

• If the image is chosen for the PhotoBook, the UNSW PhotoClub will then request for the full resolution image that is suitable for printing if needed. *If the above image dimensions are too large for email attachment, you may be asked to upload your image to cloud platforms and share the link with us.* 

## Submission Procedure

Entries must be sent to <u>competitions@unswphoto.com</u>, with an email subject of "PhotoBook 2021\_YourName", and the email (or emails) **must include** the following:

- Full Name
- Student Number
- PhotoClub Membership Number
- \* Mobile Number
- \* Categories and Titles for each of your entries
- **Portfolio Link/Instagram**, if applicable
- Photographer Name, Titles and Portfolio Links will be included in the PhotoBook alongside entries that are chosen for inclusion.
- Photos must be labelled as "Name\_Title\_Category" (e.g. "Cunio\_Untitled\_Mobile")
- Your entries may be rejected if you do not include any of the above details.
- Submissions must reach PhotoClub by 23:59, Sunday, 19th September 2021. Entries received after submissions have closed will not be valid for the competition.

# **Competition Judges**

- The competition will be judged by an external panel. *No existing PhotoClub executives will judge the winners.*
- The judging panel has the final say on all winners, inclusions into the PhotoBook, and any disqualifications that may occur in the duration of the competition.

## Winners

- Winners will be announced via email, on our website and Facebook page and at our PhotoTalk.
- There are a total of 7 winning positions, as follows:
  - One UNSW PhotoClub Photographer of the Year (POTY)
  - Seven Category winners, one for each of the categories (including the POTY)
  - Shortlisted entries from all categories will also be included in the PhotoBook
- Only current UNSW PhotoClub member can be the Photographer of the Year (POTY)
- UNSW PhotoClub reserves the right to change the prizes of the competition without prior notice.
